



Hearts Knitting Pattern

Step 1: materials

Chunky yarn

Any colour wool of your choice

Pair of knitting needles 9mm or near enough

Scissors

Tapestry needle



Step 2: Cast on 5 stitches

Step 3: Knit this row

Step 4: Increase first stitch and knit to end

Step 5: knit a row

Step 6: increase last stitch

Knit to the last stitch and increase it

Step 7: knit a row

Step 8: Increase the first stitch and knit to end

Step 9: knit 4 rows

Step 10: cut yarn and leave a few inches and push your work to the bottom of the needle it is on

Step 11: Cast on 5 stitches on the SAME needle your work is on

Step 12: repeat what you did for steps 2 to 10 but do not cut yarn.

Step 13: If you have counted correctly both pieces should now be on the same needle and look like 2 humps! This is the top of the heart.

Step 14: now join the pieces together by knitting a row across them

Step 15: Knit 4 more rows

Step 16: Decrease the first and last stitches of this row, knit in between the normally.

Step 17: knit a row

Step 18: repeat the last 2 steps until 2 stitches remain ie decrease either end 1 row, then knit a row

FINAL STEP: cut the yarn and use your tapestry needle to thread through the remaining 2 stiches to tie off and weave in all the ends, do not cut or your heart will be broken!! And stitches will come apart....trust me...I made that mistake on the first one
